



Creativity for TEACHERS

There is a strong perception that the teaching profession does not provide much scope for creative work or professional challenges. The only way in which a teacher can utilize their core skills today beyond the school is by taking tuitions. Instead, can these energies not be tapped for a creative activity like making innovative questions or curriculum? Teachers will be invited to send questions for which they may optionally use the detailed guidelines and tips on how to make good questions, which will be provided by EI. Teachers will have to send at least 5 questions in one or more subjects - English, Maths, Science and Social Studies. A panel of experienced teachers and experts will assess their questions and prizes will be awarded to a large



number of good questions. Based on the response from teachers and schools, EI plans to make this competition a regular annual feature.

THE OBJECTIVES
Traditionally question making has been considered a mechanical activity undertaken by the teacher with the sole purpose of testing what the child has absorbed from the textbook. The repetitive nature of question making and the lack of variety due to the limitations posed by the syllabus and textbooks ensured that making questions (and later correcting them) became a monotonous chore for teachers. “Over a period of time it is hoped that a competition like this will help improve the question making skills of teachers and in the process hone their skills in testing as well as deepen their subject knowledge. This will also benefit the

school as these leanings will obviously be applied there also” as said by Sridhar Rajagopalan director of Educational Initiatives. Teachers will also get feedback from educational

experts, which will help them improve. They will get to know why that particular question was selected. It will provide an avenue for teachers to exercise their creativity, while learning in the process.

The competition will generate a pool of good quality questions, many of which will be placed in the public domain and shared with schools all over the country.

As many as 15,000 schools all over India will be sent invitation and hoping for a participation of at least 10 teachers from each school. Application will be sent to the respective schools. Apart from that teachers can also log on to www.ei-india.com for registration after 21st July. The registered Teachers will be despatched a booklet titled “Tips for Making Good Multiple Choice Questions”. This booklet explains Multiple Choice Questions and gives tips on how to go about making them. The selection of winners will be done by the Test Development Team of Educational Initiatives and expert panel members. There will be a gala event taking place after the final selected of approx 20 winning teachers along with expert panels and senior members of Educational Initiatives will be present.
